A few days before the concert, we'd load eight D batteries into a massive portable stereo—the size of a toaster oven—and blast American Girl on repeat.

Water & Ecology Committee Update

We are continuing to be active with lake treatments and having our water movers and fountains in place at the beaches and common areas. Weed treatments have shown benefits already and the lake water is safe to be used to water lawns and flowers as desired. Our lake treatment provider has been on the lake a few times already to treat the water and we are waiting to see if we need the harvester to come out to remove surface level weeds and algae.

The latest service reports show good water quality, and we expect that to continue through the summer. As with every summer season, we are affected by various weather conditions. High temperatures, strong sun and dry weather can create conditions that contribute to algae growth. These are normally temporary and we will do our best to stay on top of it.

Good water flow around the lake is important to keep our waters clear. It is very important that lake front owners position their boats. particularly the larger ones, parallel to the shoreline to minimize the blockage of water flow. The water movers and fountains operate on a regular schedule to keep water flowing. With that, we want to remind all boaters and fishermen to please keep a minimum five-foot distance from these devices and their anchor lines. It is easy to disrupt the anchors and knock them out of line, and more important it is dangerous for our W&E team checking on them when they find fishhooks lodged in the anchor lines and protective netting. As always, please limit your use of fertilizer that may find its way into the lake and always bag your lawn clippings and leaves and don't let them wash into the lake, either directly or through the storm drains around the lake.

BRAP Committee Update

Boats. Rafts and Access P

Members who leased Boat Storage Spaces at an Access Point or Beach last year do not have to submit paperwork or pay any fee for the 2025 season because the Boat Storage Leases were for two years, 2024 and 2025. These leases expire November 15, 2025.

Members wanting to store a boat at an Access Point/Beach for the first time must submit a signed Application with fee. (\$40 for the 2025) season). Lease Applications are available from brap@elpoa.com.

In accordance ELPOA Rules with Regulations, all boats and anchored rafts. including inflatable anchored rafts, on ELPOA property must have a current decal.

The BRAP Committee will begin checking 2025 boat decals after June 1st, so please place your decal in a visible location on the stern of the boat.

ELPOA Security

To help protect you and your ELPOA property, we have resumed evening patrols by a licensed security officer.

While on ELPOA property, you and your household should have your 2025 ELPOA badge/tag ready to present to the security office. This is the only way the security officer can be sure of your membership. Photos of a badge on a phone or other device are NOT allowed as proof. Remember, ALL ELPOA properties are CLOSED for use after 11:00pm, unless it is being used as part of a sanctioned ELPOA event.

Guests are only allowed if accompanied by an adult ELPOA member (18 years or older).

Guests are NOT allowed to use ELPOA facilities alone. Each guest is required to give the security officer their name, address, phone number, and age.

Dogs or other animals are NEVER ALLOWED on any ELPOA property.

All bicycles (foot operated, electric or gasoline powered), scooters, hoverboards and the like are only permitted in parking lots (NOT on sidewalks, basketball or tennis courts).

No glass of any kind is allowed on any outdoor ELPOA properties.

Alcoholic beverages (including beer, wine, coolers, etc.) are prohibited at all times, unless they are part of an ELPOA sanctioned event.

Smoking of any substance, vaping, E-Cigarettes and other uses of tobacco products are prohibited on ELPOA property.

As security is not on patrol every day or all night, if you see something anytime, day or night, that requires immediate attention (vandalism, trespassing, etc.), you can call the Ringwood Police at 973-962-7017.

What Your Lifeguards Want You to Know

Your 2025 ELPOA Lifeguards are getting ready for another magical summer at Erskine Lakes! Safety is every lifeguards' first priority. Before heading to the beach, the lifeguards want to remind you:

- ▲ Lifeguards are on duty from 12:00pm-6:00pm
- ♦ Please do not talk to a lifeguard that is on the stand, they are watching the water. If you need to speak to a guard, please head to the tag check area.
- ♦ There is absolutely NO glass allowed on the beach.
- ♦ There is absolutely NO alcohol, smoking, or vaping allowed on the beach.
- ♦ After hours, please remember that there is a carry-in, carry-out policy for all trash.
- Swim only in the designated swim areas. There is no swimming allowed out of or into the swim areas from boats, paddleboards, or floats.
- ♦ There are NO boats allowed in the designated swim areas. This includes between the buoys and diving boards.
- Children under 8 years old must be supervised by a family member or caretaker at all times. This includes in the water, sand, and on the playground.
- Please show your badges each time you enter our beaches.
- ▲ Badges cannot be shared. Only those living in your household can use the badges

Lifeguards will be on duty starting Memorial Weekend. If we cannot fully staff all beaches, notification will be sent out through email and it will be posted on the ELPOA Facebook page. It is our hope that lifeguards will be on duty every weekend after Memorial Day and then full time beginning Thursday, June 19th through Labor Day.
